Doug Altman is director of the Centre for Statistics in Medicine in Oxford. He has published over 400 peer reviewed articles, many aimed at clarifying statistical ideas for medical researchers. His varied research interests include the use and abuse of statistics in medical research, studies of prognosis, regression modeling, systematic reviews, randomised trials, and studies of medical measurement.

Doug is senior statistics editor at the BMJ and co-editor-in-chief of Trials. He is actively involved in leading the developing of guidelines for reporting research, including CONSORT, STROBE, and PRISMA, and in 2006 founded the EQUATOR Network which seeks to improve the quality of scientific publications by promoting transparent and accurate reporting of health research.
